Approval of July Minutes – approved with amendment Approval of August Agenda – approved with additions Treasurer Report – Martin Steindler

Martin stepped in as treasurer because Heidi had just completed the Annual Nonprofit Corp report which required a designated treasurer, with Anne's approval and Martin's acceptance of the responsibility. Clarification was provided for expenses. Payroll taxes needs clarification for better accuracy in reporting. Records are needed to specify which funds from the Flea Market go into operations checking and which are to be allocated to RE.

RE Coordinator Report

-Fall Programming - Jamie proposed programming designed to share focus on PreK-K, grades 1-5, and grades 6-12 groups on alternating Sundays. There will always be Sunday RE (soon to be Spiritual Exploration or SE) with at least 2 adults. The proposal included request for additional funding of \$675 to pay \$75 to 9 "experts" or guest speakers, (3 for each of the categories to be scheduled 1 guest per month for the 9 months of the church calendar). Motion passed. Sari Embley is going to MBank to transfer \$675 from Joan's Bequest into the operations checking account. The proposal also included request to pay Raymond Lenberg as RE teacher. The BoT was reminded of the policy of not paying members for services which includes exceptions. A job description will need to be provided and pay amount decided on by RE Coordinator Jamie Kuehnl & the RE committee.

-Playground update — installation will begin once all the parts are at the meeting house including parts that need replacing that will hopefully be provided through the manufacturer due to Lifetime warranty. Jamie provided a visual of the placement of the playground in front of the meeting house with fencing separating the play area and the parking lot.
